- Total land area of 46 m ha. Forested area is 39.3 m ha of which 15.2 m ha (39%) has been classified as Productive with 11.2 m ha having harvest rights secured by Government.
- National allowable cut is quoted as 3.9 m m3 but the actual annual harvest is nearer to 3 m m3.
- Log exports currently at a level of 2.5 m to 3.0 m per annum.
- About 80% of export logs go to China and 10% to Japan.

- Ownership of almost all forested land in PNG remains with the traditional landowners and access can only be gained to these after Government has negotiated an agreement with these landowners.
- Monitoring and control of all forest operations is the responsibility of the PNG Forest Authority (PNGFA).
- PNGFA has appointed SGS (since 1994) to monitor all export log shipments on its behalf.
- PNGFA continues to monitor all processed forest product exports.






Log Exports 1992 – 2006 (million M3)




Log Export Value Per M3



Total Value Log Exports (millions)




Log Exports By Destination %



Export Tax and Landowner Payments As % FOB Value

- From 1-01-07 export tax is 28.5% of FOB
- Landowners will receive K10/m3 royalty, K8/m3 development levy and K14/m3(est) cash and in kind payment
- Plantation log exports are exempt from export tax and the levy



Production and exports of processed products has grown steadily in response to changing market demand and new processing plant investment. Wood processing has been one of the fastest growing manufacturing sectors of the PNG economy over the last 10 years.
